studio Nicolas Vrignaud

An interdisciplinary design studio based in Paris, working across the fields of architecture and landscape. Formerly known as B Head Room (2003-2022), the studio is led by architects Nicolas Vrignaud and Analía García Ramírez.

Their work operates at the intersection of art, architecture, and design, with references spanning spatial design, urban design, scenography, and signage.

The studio favors a conceptual, contextual, and cross-disciplinary approach tailored to the specificities of each project. The complementary skills of the two partners converge around projects that are ambitious in concept, detail, and user experience.

The studio's expertise is supported by a network of specialists-architects, designers, and graphic artists. Its scale allows for continuous cross-disciplinary dialogue, which nourishes the thinking behind each project.

Nicolas Vrignaud

An architect graduated in 2001 from the École d'Architecture de Bretagne, Nicolas Vrignaud moved to Paris in 2000 and founded the studio b head room in 2003, later joined by Analía García Ramírez in 2007. With a background in applied arts, he developed a multidisciplinary approach to design and architecture. His final thesis project focused on the Euroméditerranée development, with Ruedi Baur as jury president—a collaboration that continued within Intégral Ruedi Baur & Associés, where he refined a systemic and context-driven methodology.

Since 2003, he has collaborated with architecture and landscape firms, working in scenography and design. He was co-winner, with Jean-Marc Louazon, of the design competition for Le Parcours des Rescapés, commemorating the centenary of the Courrières mining disaster (1906)—a project that marked his deep engagement with urban and memorial design.

He has led numerous projects in collaboration with renowned architects such as Manuelle Gautrand (Citroën showroom, Gaîté Lyrique), Patrick Berger & Jacques Anziutti (Rennes Métropole headquarters), and Jakob + MacFarlane (Cité de la Mode et du Design), where he implemented a sensitive, contextaware design approach.

Analía García Ramírez

A graduate of the Escuela Técnica Superior de Arquitectura de Madrid (ETSAM) in 1999, Analía García Ramírez has been living in Paris since 2001. She has collaborated with Nicolas Vrignaud since 2007 within the studio b head room.

She worked in New York and Paris with Imrev Culbert, notably on the Louvre-Lens Museum (award-winning project with SANAA), where she was project lead. There, she developed a user-centered approach, focusing on the enhancement of artworks and visitor experience.

In Paris, she collaborated with Paul Andreu and ADPI on the Oriental Art Center's Philharmonic Hall in Shanghai, incorporating the notion of choreographed spatial pathways. She also contributed to prestigious projects such as the Atlanta Symphony Center (Santiago Calatrava), the Onassis Foundation (Architecture Studio), and the Gaîté Lyrique (Manuelle Gautrand).

Analía brings an artistic and scenographic perspective to her work, with projects such as Ablando (Andalusian Department of Culture) and Happening (Netherlands Architecture Institute, Rotterdam).

Her career has given her transversal expertise in architecture, scenography, acoustics, lighting, and design, applied to a wide range of projects: cultural, high-end residential, transport, and retail.
